Bring frequently used office supplies and documents within easy reach using mobile storage units

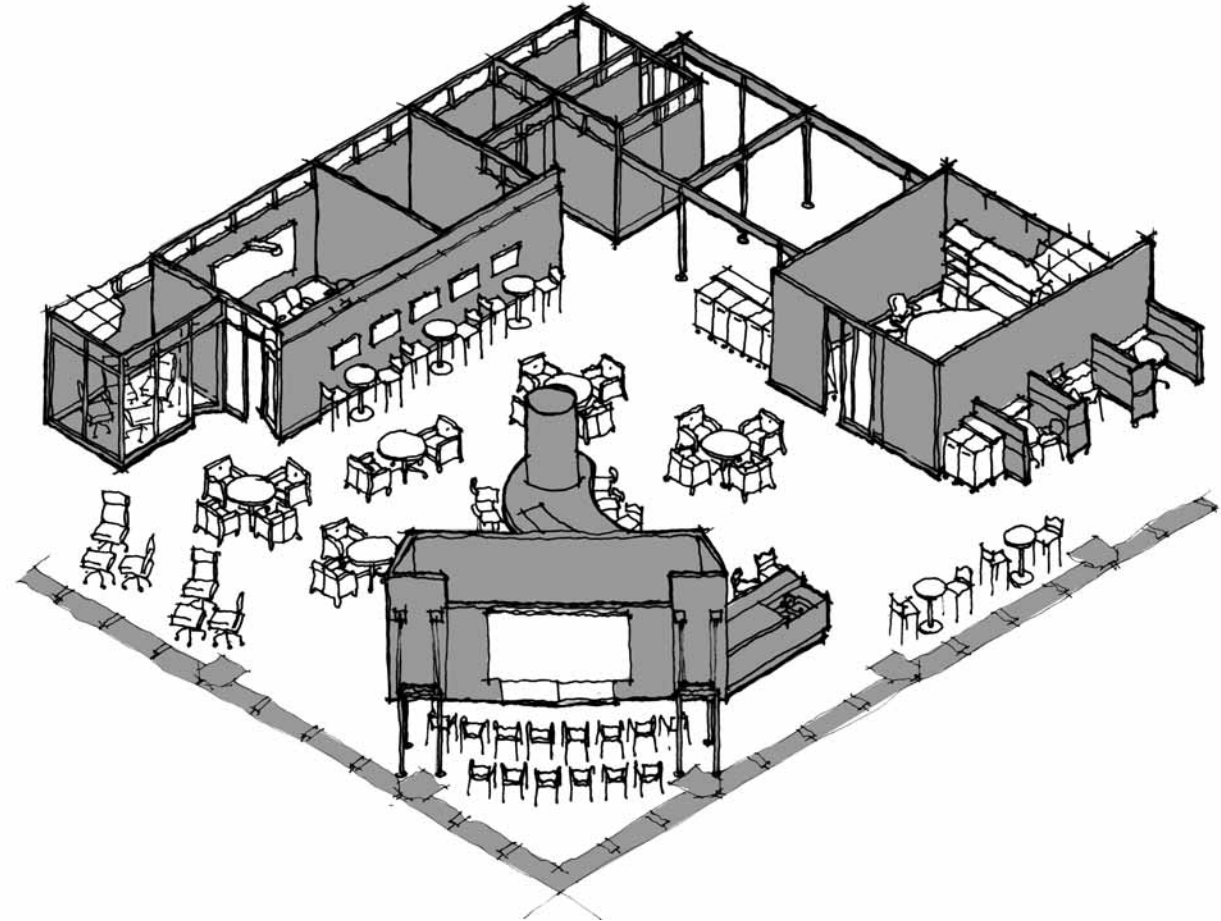
