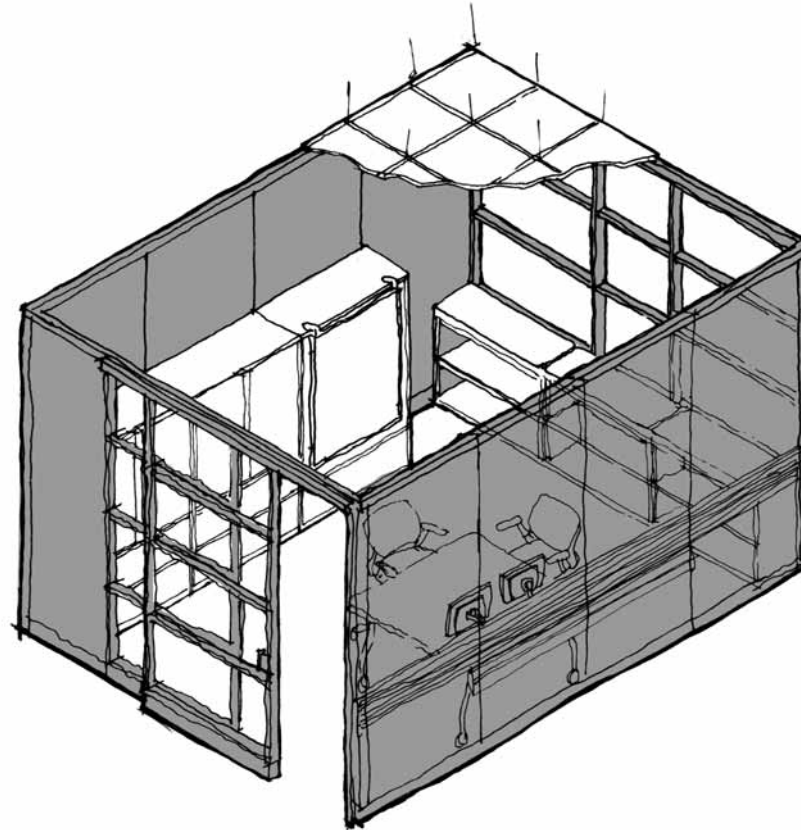
**Managing Connections**
