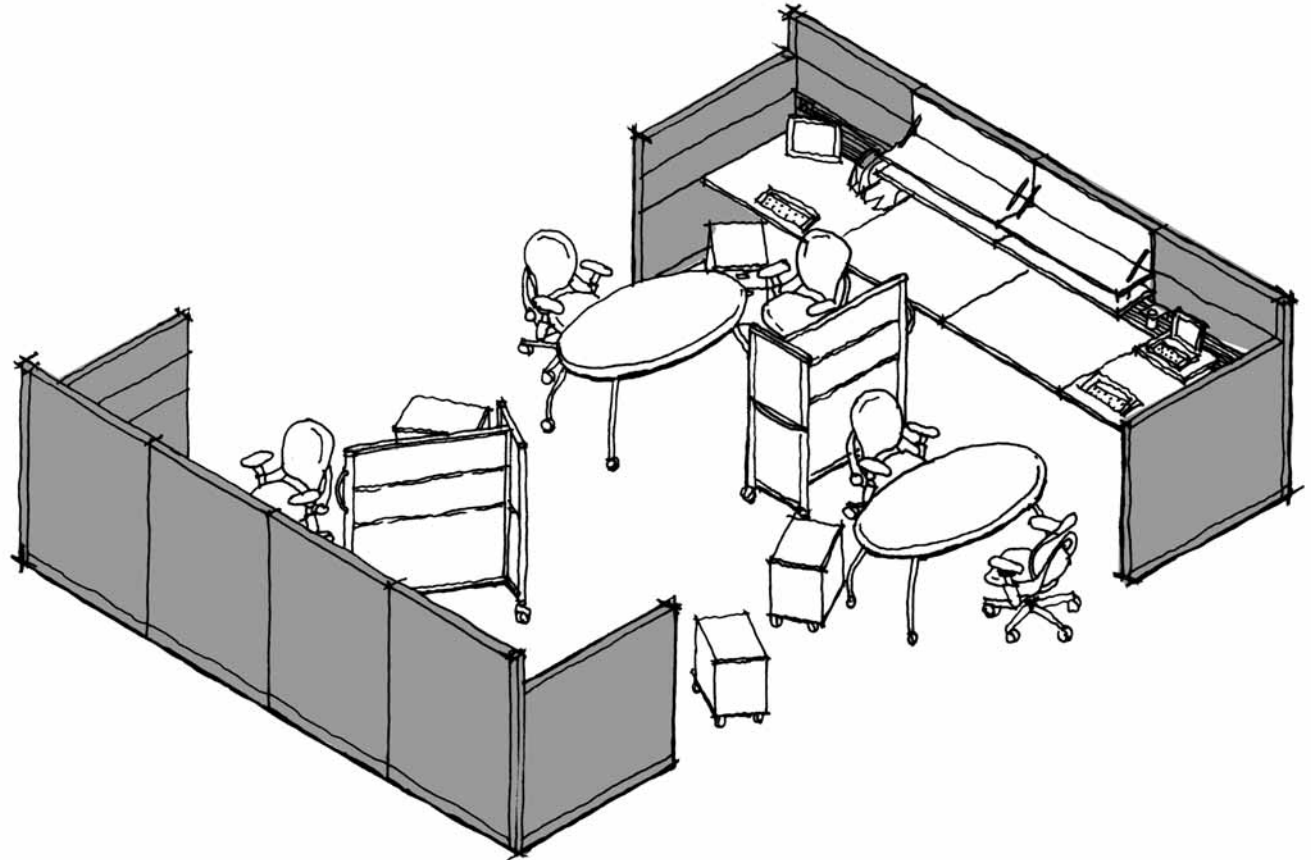
Access power and communications at desk height using furniture panels
